



Data Aggregation Monthly Update

September 2020

CMS has temporarily suspended its participation in multi-payer data aggregation within the CPC+ Michigan region because of a compliance issue. CMS participation in every CPC+ multi-payer data aggregation region requires two non-CMS payer participants. To efficiently and accurately meet this goal, we are working with the Michigan Data Collaborative to ensure that data for CMS and the other two CPC+ payers are included in the CPC+ Multi-payer Dashboard, and that aggregated data from all three payers is made available to CPC+ practices as accurately and quickly as possible.

As a result of these efforts, there are some modifications to the release schedule and approach. The 9/17/2020 release to include Medicare FFS and BCBSM data through Q1 2020 will be delayed due a contractual matter. The Michigan Data Collaborative will simultaneously deliver the following data on December 2020:

- Medicare FFS and Blue Cross Blue Shield claims data through Q1 2020
- Medicare FFS, Blue Cross Blue Shield, and Priority Health claims data through Q2 2020 this December 2020.

The Michigan Data Collaborative will provide more information regarding the details of this upcoming release.

CMS remains committed to collaborating with regional payer partners to include their data along with Medicare FFS data in multi-payer data aggregation tools so practices can use the data to drive primary care transformation. We appreciate the engagement of the payers, practices and providers in helping drive primary care transformation and your continued adoption and use of aggregated data in this work.
