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About the ED Detail Reports

Each row in the ED Detail Report includes detailed information about an individual ED visit for a participating patient during the **most recent six months** of complete data available. The date range is included in the report header.

There are two types of ED Detail Reports:

- **ED Detail Report** – This report provides detailed information for each ED visit broken out by Practice.
File format: <PO Name>_<Practice Name>_ED_Detail_YYYY_MM.xls
- **PO ED Detail Report** – This report provides the same detailed information as the ED Detail Report, but for all patients in the PO.

File format: <PO Name>_ED_Detail_All_Practices_YYYY_MM.xls

A: Patient Identification Information

The first 12 columns provide patient identification information.

You can click the up/down arrows (▲▼) next to most headings to sort the list/report based on that heading. The sort arrows display when you hover the pointer over the heading name on the report.

B: ED Visit Information

The following table provides information about some of the ED visit-related columns:

Column Heading	Description
New ED Visit From Last Report	Because the 6 month reporting period may overlap a previous report, this ED indicator signifies a new ED visit since the last report. NOTE: All ED visits are new for the first report (released March 7, 2013).
Proportion PCS Rate	The number of ED visits likely to be Primary Care Sensitive (PCS) The ED Utilization Dashboards and Reports use the NYU Algorithm to calculate the PCS Probability. For more information about the NYU Algorithm, see http://wagner.nyu.edu/faculty/billings/nyued-background.php .
Asthma ED Visits for Previously Diagnosed Asthma	The number of asthma-related ED visits over the past six months for patients who were previously diagnosed with asthma.
